

Betha Program Policies

General terms of Betha students

- Maintaining a cumulative GPA of 2.8/4 for BA/undergraduate students and 3.0 for Master/postgraduate students.
- The number of hours registered in the semester should not be less than (15) credit hours for BA, except the following cases:
 - o Lack of courses for registration. An evidence should be submitted to the ICT Fund.
 - o Summer semester
 - o The student's last semester
- The period of study must not exceed 5 years for BA students, 2 years for full-time Master students, and 3 years for part-time Master students.

Students Stipend System

BA/undergraduate degree students

The scholarship student enrolled in the BA/undergraduate program is granted stipend on a semester basis. At the end of each semester, a stipend of AED 5,000 will be deposited of which AED 2,000 will be deducted and deposited in a special account with the ICT Fund. The deducted amount will be paid to the student upon graduation and adherence to the scholarship stipulated terms.

Master's/postgraduate degree students

The scholarship student enrolled in Master's/postgraduate program is granted stipend on a semester basis. At the end of each semester, a stipend of AED 10,000 will be deposited of which AED 4,000 will be deducted and deposited in a special account with the ICT Fund. The deducted amount will be paid to the student upon graduation and adherence to the scholarship stipulated terms, on the condition that he/she is registered in a full-time study program.

The stipend will be suspended in the following cases:

1. Not registering in the semester, including the summer semester
2. Graduation from the university
3. Achieving a cumulative GPA of less than 2.8/4

Warnings

A warning will be sent to the scholarship student in the following situations:

For BA/undergraduate students:

1. Cumulative GPA is less than 2.0
2. Failing or withdrawing from the course.
3. Not committing to the number of hours agreed upon between the ICT Fund and the student (15 credit hours per semester), except the following cases:
 - a. Lack of courses for registration. An evidence should be submitted to the ICT Fund.
 - b. Summer semester
 - c. The student's last semester

For Master's/postgraduate students:

1. Cumulative GPA is less than 3.0
2. Not committing to the number of hours agreed upon between the ICT Fund and the student (9 credit hours for full time, 3 credit hours for part-time), except the following cases:
 - a. Lack of courses for registration. An evidence should be submitted to the ICT Fund.
 - b. Summer semester
 - c. The student's last semester

Termination of the scholarship

The ICT Fund may terminate the scholarship when the following violations occur:

- The student received three warnings by the ICT Fund
- Changing the specialization without prior permission
- Drop out for a semester without prior permission
- Any other reason as determined by ICT Fund.
